## Instructions

This craft can be used to practice Halloween characters by having children knock on the door and reveal the character underneath.

This craft can take between 5-10 minutes to complete. Younger children may need supervision and assistance when using scissors and brads.

The characters on page 3 are from “Knock Knock, Trick Or Treat?” on *Super Simple Songs - Halloween*.

### What you need:

- Scissors
- A brad or pipecleaner for the center of the wheel

- Printout of the Halloween House (page 2)\*
- Printout of a Character Wheel (page 3)\*


\*Printing on card stock (thick paper) is recommended.

#### Step 1:


Cut out the Halloween House (page 2).

Cut out the Character Wheel.

attach them together with a brad (or pipecleaner).
